No.	CLUE (First letter)	UK RIVER
e.g.	The Uk's longest river, rises in central Wales & flows southwards to its mouth in the Bristol Channel (S)	Severn
1	This river flows through Glasgow, & was once a major shipbuilding centre (C)	
2	Sometimes called the Isis in Oxford (T)	
3	Northern Ireland's longest river; the upper part flows into Lough Neagh, & the lower part into the Atlantic (B)	
4	Rises in the North Pennines & flows south-east before entering the North Sea at Middlesbrough (T)
