IDENTIFY THE FOLLOWING FAMOUS ROADS OR STREETS FROM THE CLUES GIVEN:

| No. | CLUE | ROAD/STREET |
|---------------------|--|-----------------------------------|
| e.g. | Street in New York's financial district named after a stockade built in 1653 to protect the area from attack | Wall Street |
| 1 | Latin name for Jerusalem street, frequented by Christian pilgrims, translates as 'way of grief' | Via Dolorosa |
| 2 | Theatre district of New York, known as the 'Great White Way' because of its brilliant lighting | Broadway |
| 3 | Site of the President of Singapore's residence, probably named for the fruit trees that used to grow there | Orchard Road |
| 4 | 250km long coastal route in Victoria, Australia, from which rock stacks – 'The Twelve Apostles', can be seen | Great Ocean Road |
| 5 | Thoroughfare in Paris that runs between the Arc de Triomphe & the Place de La Concorde | Champs-Elysees |
| 6 | This north London road features on the cover of a 1969 Beatles album | Abbey Road |
| 7 | Named in honour of Argentina's Independence Day, the Buenos Aires Street said to be the widest in the world | 9th July Avenue |
| 8 | Thoroughfare linking Edinburgh Castle & Holyrood Palace | The Royal Mile |
| 9 | Orbital motorway that encircles London | M25 |
| 10 | Road in Bangkok, which translates as 'Milled Rice', site of many backpackers hostels | Khao San Road |
| 11 | Avenue in Berlin, lined with lime trees, from which it takes its name | Unter Den Linden |
| 12 | Ancient Roman road, begun in 312 BCE, that stretched from Rome to Campania | Appian Way |
| 13 | San Francisco's crooked street | Lombard Street |
| 14 | Historic US highway sometimes known as the 'Mother Road' | Route 66 |
| 15 | Street that runs from Temple Bar at the boundary with the City of Westminster to Ludgate Circus | Fleet Street |
